A year like no other

#### FROM OUR BOARD CHAIR AND EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

2020 is inextricably linked to the COVID-19 pandemic forevermore, but in the midst of unspeakable loss, there has also been learning. Appreciation of the vital role front-line workers play in our health care system has never been stronger. Awareness of the critical role of public health is at the forefront and recognition of the key role scientific innovation plays in solving global health problems is evident in the swift emergence of vaccines.

  online conferencing platforms and worked with our partners to venture into the world

  students combined to create a fun and meaningful career exploration experience at
  our Fall Discovery Day events.
- While construction of our new offices and Exhibit Hall in London, Ontario was postponed, it will be finished and ready for when it is safe again to receive guests indoors.

Thanks to financial support of the Canadian Medical Association, we moved forward in the development of our new website and virtual hall which will feature many new design elements to better showcase the accomplishments of our Laureates.

When we think of our Laureates certain words universally come to mind: perseverance, collaboration, entrepreneurial spirit, resiliency. Seeing these traits in action amongst the global health community as they worked tirelessly to provide care and develop policy, therapeutics and vaccines provided a well of inspiration to clinicians and medical researchers new to their fields, and to youth who aspire to achieving similar health science impacts one day.

Distinguished Professor of Psychiatry at the University of Manitoba whose seminal publications addressing psychosocial dimensions of palliation have helped define core-competencies and standards of end-of-life care.



#### Marco Marra OBC PhD FRSC FCAHS Vancouver, BC

Head of the Personalized Oncogenomics project at BC Cancer, one of the first applications of whole genome sequencing in a clinical setting, using information derived from thousands of individual cancer genomes and transcriptomes to identify promising therapeutic targets in individual patients.



#### Jean Gray CM MD FRCPC FRCP FCAHS Halifax, NS

Praised and admired for her wide-ranging knowledge of pharmacotherapeutics and her devotion to evidence-informed practice, she has championed rigorous studies of drug safety and effectiveness to improve prescribing practice.

Former Dean of Harvard Medical School distinguished for his ability to promote collaboration in building and expanding the institutional foundations of medical education and science in North America.

#### UNLOCKING THE MYSTERIES OF THE BRAIN | ONLINE LEARNING MODULE

While we were unable to deliver our regular in-person programming, this year provided the opportunity to develop new educational resources to excite students in grades seven and eight about health sciences through an interactive learning module that encourages young minds to unlock the mysteries of the brain.

Set to launch in 2021, this new educational resource will include captivating videos, interactive games, and inspiring lessons focused on the human brain. Accessible across the country, teachers can use this tool to introduce their students to the various parts and regions of the brain, common neurological diseases, and to CMHF Laureates who have made significant contributions to brain research in Canada and the world.

At the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame, we understand the importance of partnership and collaboration. We deeply value the support of our local partners who have been instrumental in the development of this project–the Brain and Mind Institute at Western University and the Alzheimer Society of London and Middlesex.
