We celebrate the remarkable achievements of Canada's healthcare giants, not only to instill pride but also to inspire the next generation of health leaders poised to create transformative change.

Established in 2015, the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame (CMHF) Award is creating a national community of emerging leaders and innovators committed to improving health. One student in each of Canada's 17 medical schools receives a \$5,000 cash award and opportunity to attend the CMHF Induction Ceremony. Award recipients submit a 1,000-word essay describing why they should be considered for the award and which CMHF Laureate inspires them most.

HONOURING EXCELLENCE & BUILDING COMMUNITY


Through the CMHF Award we aim to:
