Dr. Poulin has served as the Medical Director and spokesperson for the Addictions Foundation of Manitoba and as medical lead for the Rapid Access to Addictions Medicine (RAAM) clinics across Manitoba. She has supported various boards on regional, provincial and national levels, including the Canadian Mental Health Association.

Dr. Poulin is also an Assistant Professor in the Department of Family Medicine and Director of the Clinical Enhancement and Mentorship Program for the University of Manitoba. She serves as the Clinical Lead, Prairie Node, Canadian Research Initiative in Substance Misuse. She has been a principal and co-investigator and collaborator on multiple research studies and is also a published author including national guidelines in the field of Addiction Medicine.
