BRADLEY, Dr. John: Co-founded the Wainwright Medical Clinic in Alberta.

COCHRANE, Dr. William: Developed the Cochrane (L-leucine) test which identifies a type of hypoglycemia involving protein intake sensitivity. Served as President of University of Calgary 1974-1978.

COLLIP, Dr. James: Refined and purified insulin to a form for clinical use; received his MD from University of Alberta.

FINLAY, Dr. B. Brett: Extending our understanding of microbe-human interaction in both health and disease. Received his undergraduate and PhD from the University of Alberta.

LOUGHEED, The Honourable Peter: Established the Alberta Heritage Medical Research Foundation. Born in Calgary and attended University of Alberta.

MACKENZIE, Dr. Walter: A true visionary in medical education and research; Professor and Dean of Faculty of Medicine in University of Alberta 1959-1974.

MAK, Dr. Tak Wah: Identified the structure of the T cell receptor for antigens, a valuable discovery in the field of immunology; received his PhD from University of Alberta.

McEACHERN, Dr. John: Founding president of Canadian Society for the Control of Cancer, later called the Canadian Cancer Society. President of Alberta Medical Association.

TYRRELL, Dr. D. Lorne: Discovered antiviral therapy drug for treating Hepatitis B virus (liver disease); Completed undergraduate and MD at University of Alberta, served as Dean of Faculty of Medicine 1994-2004.
